

Love and Logic®: Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Do I need to register for both a Part 1 and a Part 2 of the course (both CRN's)?

A. Yes, we recommend that students enroll in both six-week sections to complete the course and to be eligible for a certificate of attendance at the end of 12 weeks.

Q: Is there assistance to help me register for this class if English is not my first language?

A. Yes, if English is not your primary language we have staff available to help you with the process of applying for a student ID number and registering for classes. Assistance is available in the following languages: Spanish, Vietnamese, Chinese, and Korean. You can call NOCE StarHelp and in most cases, speak with someone immediately in a language mentioned above, or make an appointment to speak with staff at a time that is convenient for you. Q: Can I still register for the class after the start date (first class meeting)?

A. Yes, you may register for the course at any time during the semester. However, we recommend registering prior to the start of the fourth week of the first section so that you can learn all of the strategies taught in the course, and to be eligible for a certificate of attendance at the end of 12 weeks. If you are not able to register by the fourth week of the current semester and you need a certificate of attendance, you can enroll in one of the Love & Logic® classes being offered in the next academic semester.

Q. Is this class for parents with children of a certain age?

A. Love and Logic® classes teach simple and effective strategies for parenting children of all ages, from birth to adulthood.

Q. About how much time per week will it take to watch the class videos and read the class materials?

A. We recommend that you allow approximately 1.5 hours per week to view and participate in all of the class materials posted in Canvas, NOCE's online learning system. Additionally, we have a weekly one hour live Zoom meeting for you to participate in. Keep in mind, you can log into Canvas at your convenience 24 hours a day, 7days a week to access course materials!

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Q. How do I earn a certificate of attendance for this class?

A. *There are two ways a student can earn a certificate of attendance:*

- 1. Students must participate in online faculty-led learning through instructional videos in Canvas, contribute to the weekly Canvas discussion board, and attend a minimum of 8 of the 12 one-hour weekly Zoom calls.*

Or

- 2. Participate in self-led learning by completing workbook readings and activities independently and participate in a minimum of 8 of the 12 one-hour weekly Zoom calls.*

Q. Do I have to attend all the weekly Zoom meetings?

A. *We highly recommend you attend the weekly Zoom meetings! During the Zoom meetings, your instructor will reinforce the course materials presented in Canvas, as well as create a space for community where parents/caregivers can ask questions and share their success stories after applying the Love and Logic® techniques. In order to earn the certificate of attendance, you must participate in a minimum of 8 of the 12 one-hour weekly Zoom calls (see above).*

Q. Can I bring my child to the weekly online Zoom meetings?

A. *This is an adult only class and is available to adult students 18 years of age or older. If you are interested in taking a class with your child, visit the NOCE class schedule at noce.edu/schedule to learn more about the parent and me classes offered in the Parenting Program.*

Q. Can I attend any of the weekly Zoom calls, or just the call scheduled for the class I am taking?

A. *You may log into any of the Zoom calls for the week that best fits your schedule.*

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Q. Are the classes and the class materials free?

A. Yes, this class is tuition-free to the student. These courses are state-funded through the North Orange County Regional Consortium for Adult Education.

Q. How do I get my class workbook once I have registered for the class?

A. Workbook readings are available in Canvas and are divided up by week. You can also request a hard copy workbook be mailed directly to you.

Q. Will I get a grade at the end of the class?

A. Students will receive either a pass (P) or no pass (NP) grade.

Q. If I am court ordered to take a parenting class, will this class meet the court's requirement?

A. Many Orange County courts have accepted the Love and Logic® parenting classes to meet this requirement. We recommend you confirm this with your case manager, or a professional that is working with you on your case.

Q. How many classes do I have to attend to get a certificate of attendance for the court?

A. There are two ways to earn the certificate of attendance:

- 1. Students must participate in online faculty-led learning through instructional videos in Canvas, contribute to the weekly Canvas discussion board, and attend a minimum of 8 of the 12 one-hour weekly Zoom calls.*

Or

- 2. Participate in self-led learning by completing workbook readings and activities independently and participate in a minimum of 8 of the 12 one-hour weekly Zoom calls.*
