 - Work Experience (20): A program where students gain hands-on, practical experience in a job related to their field of study.
 - o **Directed Study (Independent Study)[40]:** A self-guided learning experience where a student works independently on a specific topic or project under the supervision of an instructor.
 - o Asynchronous Online (71): Classes with no set meeting times and are fully online.
 - o **Synchronous Online (72):** Classes meet online at scheduled times, as listed in the class schedule and syllabus. Like an in-person class but held online.
 - o HY: Online instruction with scheduled on-campus meetings required.
