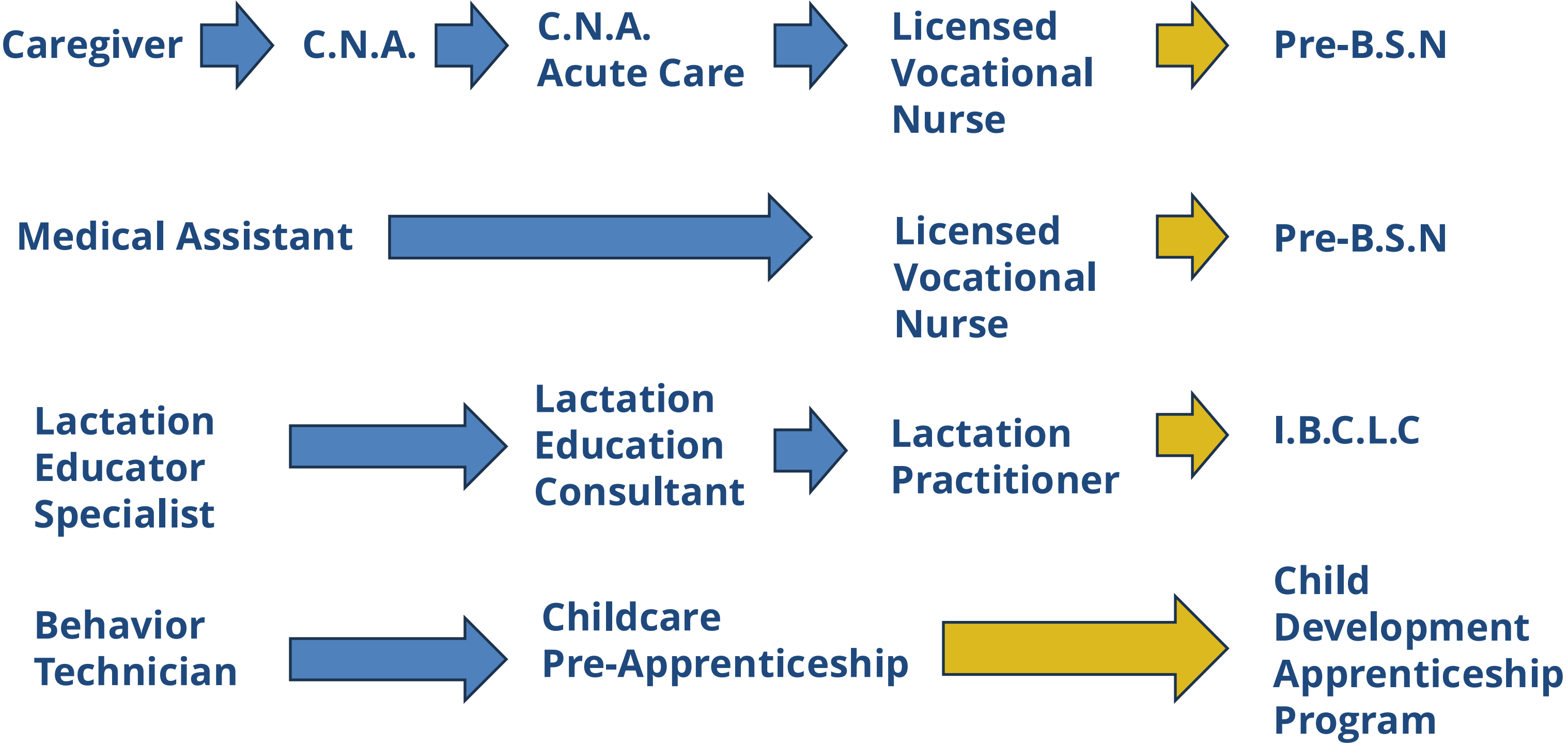

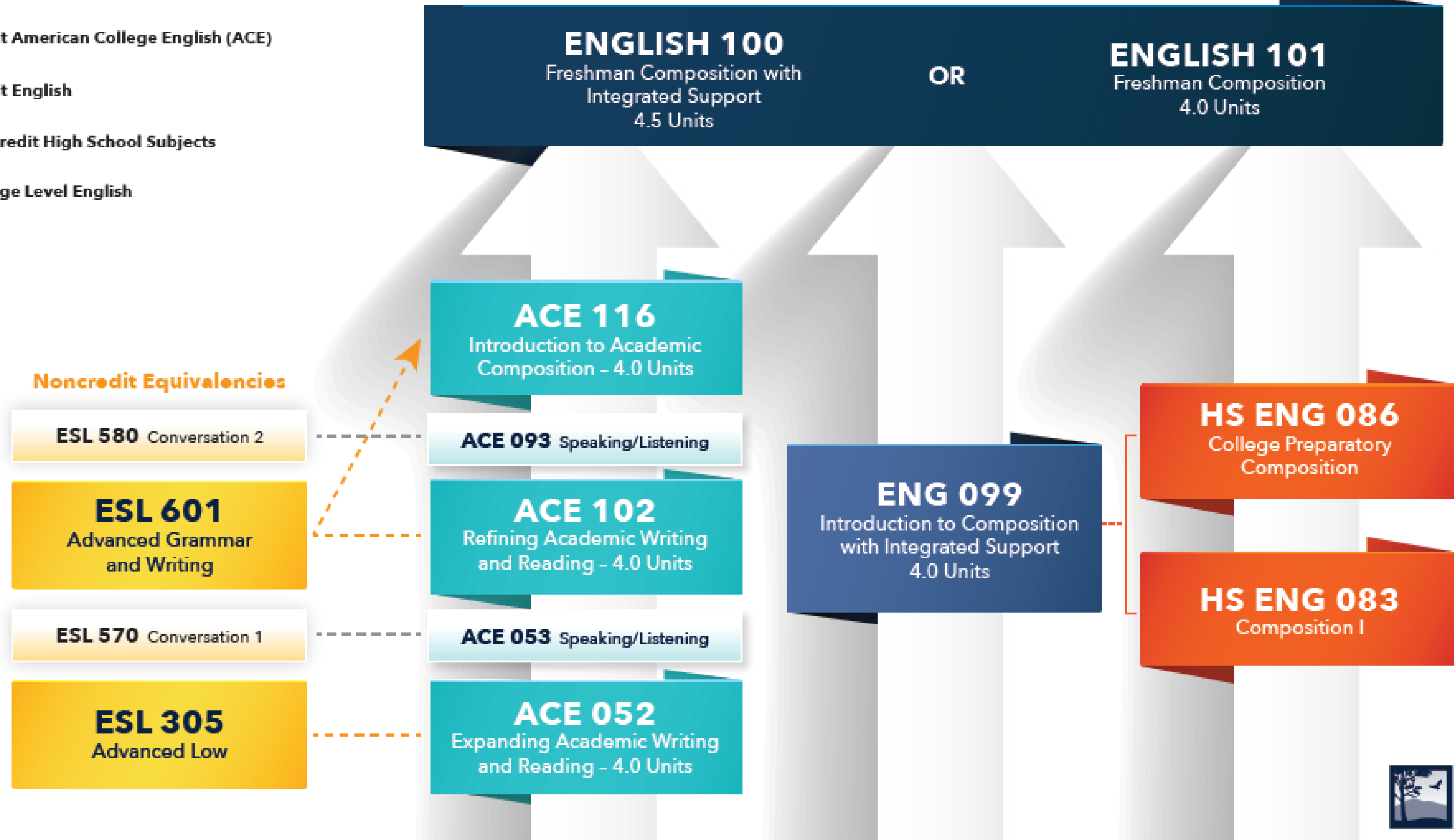

  - Advocate for Noncredit Programs and Resources collegially.

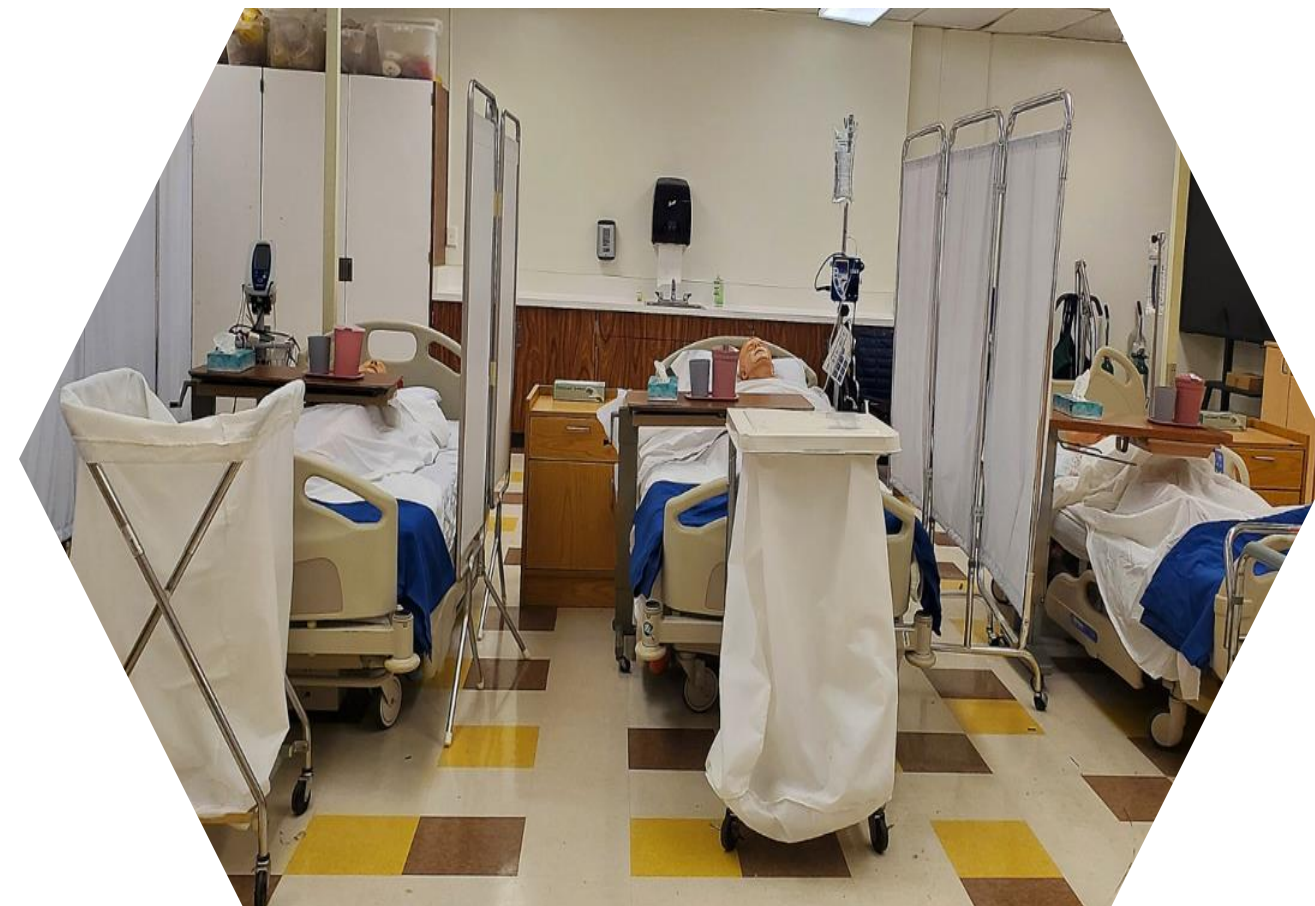
## 3. Dispelling myths about noncredit classes

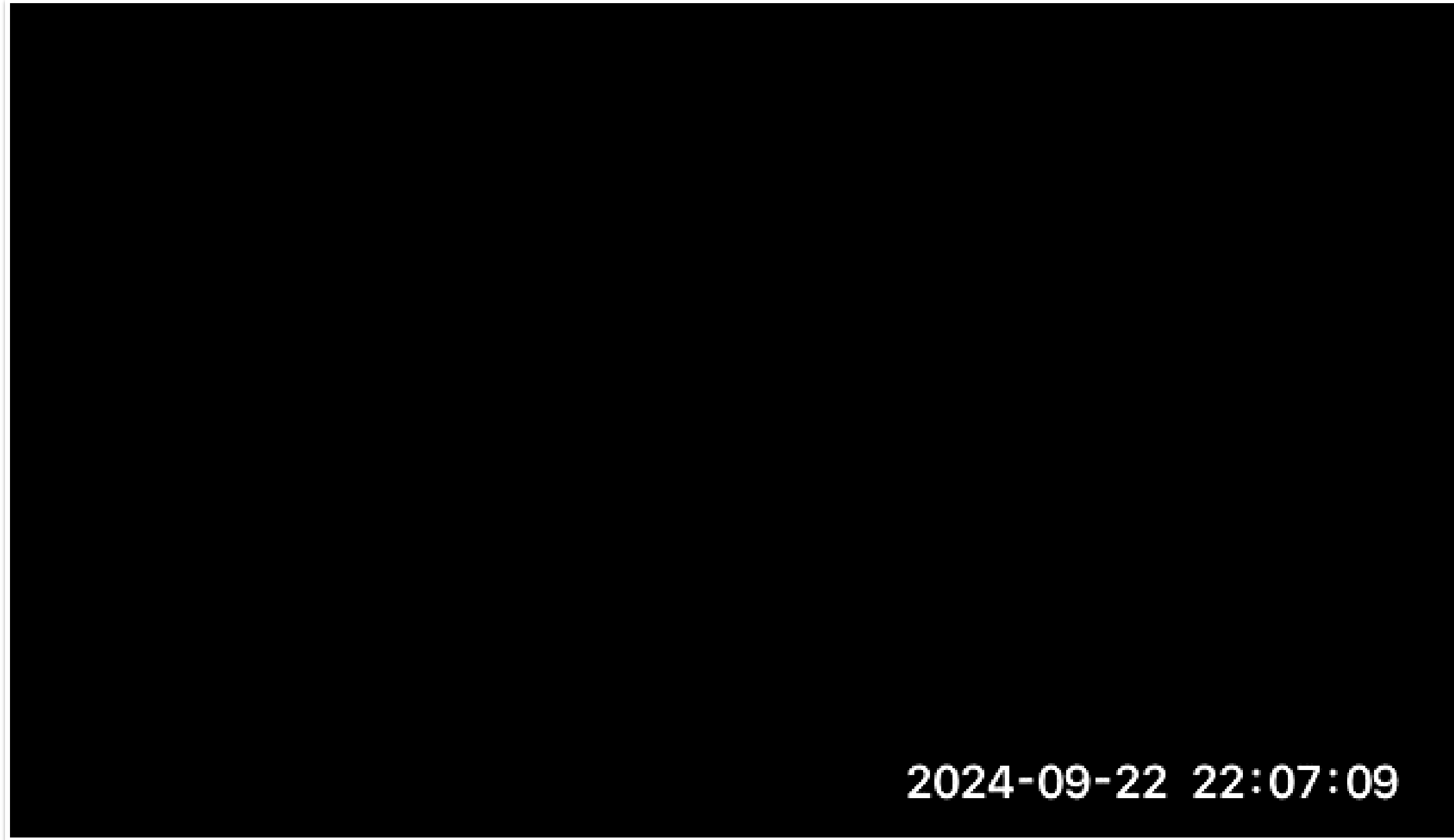

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# Healthcare Pathways for English Language Learners

- **Data collection of ESL students in CTE healthcare courses**
  - Certified Nursing Assistant, Caregiver
- **Course Development**
  - Two course outline of records leading to a program certificate.
  - Contextualized curriculum for ESL learners covering healthcare topics, medical terminology, and grammar skills.
- **CNA instructor input**
  - Content e.g., Patient Rights, Vital Signs, Body Mechanics, etc.
  - Areas of support: oral explanations, verbs/adverbs, modals, exam vocabulary, etc.
- **Fall 2024 Cohort**
  - ESL 801 Patient Care Skills, ESL 800 ESL for Healthcare Careers
    - Program certificate: ESL for CAN and Caregiving
