Healthcare Pathways for English Language Learners

Data collection of ESL students in CTE healthcare courses

Certified Nursing Assistant, Caregiver

Course Development

- Two course outline of records leading to a program certificate.
- Contextualized curriculum for ESL learners covering healthcare topics, medical terminology, and grammar skills.

CNA instructor input

- Content e.g., Patient Rights, Vital Signs, Body Mechanics, etc.
- Areas of support: oral explanations, verbs/adverbs, modals, exam vocabulary, etc.

Fall 2024 Cohort

- ESL 801Patient Care Skills, ESL 800 ESL for Healthcare Careers
 - Program certificate: ESL for CAN and Caregiving



Vision 2030 Alignment

- Presentation of healthcare courses in Career Education
 - Bridging ESL and Career Education
 - In-person and online presentations of certificate programs.
- Partnerships
 - United Domestic Workers (UDW)
 - Workforce training to caregivers to upskill and create upward mobility
- Vision 2030
 - Improve social and economic mobility
 - Increase the number of students who complete an educational outcome.
